 Rex Bell and Karl Tatgenhorst -- 11.5%



JHS class presidents share their opinions on the upcoming 2016 Presidential Election




Lizzy Bishop -- 2017

Reece Elder -- 2020


1.) "I would make it just as easy for the lower class to get a job like the upper class. They would just have to work for it."
